Episode Eight
The Use of Amendments

You might wonder who the “they and them” are that I am speaking about, as in *Episode seven* when I said “they will infiltrate your groups”. That is a good question. “These” and “they” are *not* the people who support the other political party or philosophy, the rich guys or the poor guys, the group we do not like, or some group of political ninjas. The answer is found in the Bible. The “them” and “these” are ministers of Satan which, appear in every group of people, present themselves as the best of us, and work to influence and control, for evil, those in any positions of authority who make the decisions which affect that societyⁱ.

Romans 1:18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness;

In the text the words *hold the truth* mean to *cover and withhold the truth*. These are evil men and women who work for Satan. Who know the truth yet they seek to cover the truth of God concerning Jesus Christ and withhold that truth from those seeking to know.

2nd Corinthians 11:13 For such *are* false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. 14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. 15 Therefore *it is* no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

These seek to mislead people away from God and to lies that hurt those so lead. Freedom comes from knowing and doing God's Wordⁱ To achieve his goals concerning government the devil works diligently to cover over, twist, and or if he can, forbid men and women knowing the Word of God. Two things the devil has tried to cover over are the biblical truth concerning the manifestation of the gift of holy spirit and the importance of the Apostle Paul's Epistles. This has gone on for centuries and will continue until the endⁱⁱ.

As the devil has worked to cover over, twist and confuse the teaching of all that Christ has accomplished for us, so the devil has via his evil men and women tried to cover over, twist and confuse men and womens understanding concerning how and why our constitution, as ratified, was to operate, including the application and use of amendments. Constitutionally we the people will, by way of amendments, add to, take away from and change what vested powers we clearly, expressly, particularly grant our government.ⁱⁱⁱ This is as close to democracy as our constitution gets, and gives more power to the people than any other government in history, including any so called "Greek or socialist democracies".

Since the constitution of the United States of America was ratified, evil and greedy men and women have done a great deal to convince we the people that the method of amendment does not or could not work for practical changes which are needed to run the government. Many good men and women have been so grievously instructed in this lie that they now believe it to be right². I have even heard it taught that none other than Goerge Washington agreed with this. Yet here is what the first president did say in his farewell address to congress.

This government the offspring of our own choice , uninfluenced and unawed, adapted upon full

investigation and mature deliberation, completely free in its principles, in the distribution of its powers uniting security with energy, and containing within itself a provision for its own amendment has a just claim to your confidence and support. - George Washington, "farewell address"

The actual, primal, reason evil and greedy men and women work to seduce we the people to believe that amendments will not work is that using amendments greatly limits their ability to abuse and misconstrue the powers vested in the government. Those who ratified our constitution understood from history that evil men and women have lobbied to convince kings, queens, parliament and congress, \$\$\$\$, to give them power³. To avoid corruption of congress it was decided that all changes made in the powers vested in the government would rest with we the people by way of our state or convention elected representatives.^{iv}

The power of people united in believing is the greatest power in the physical realm. When people come together to form a government they produce such power. The lust, in some, to control and use that power is incredible. They are willing to pay great sums to have access and control of that power, this we see in history⁴. Those who ratified our constitution understood that given enough "good reasons" then the congress, courts, and president can all get behind making laws in favor of those seeking the power. Even when those laws are not constitutional. Slowly over the years we the people have lost sight of the problems of unrestricted government. Those who seek to abuse and make misconstruction of our power have worked to train the people to think that giving the government greater power is good and will not lead to the problems that existed all around the world prior to our constitution's tenth amendment.

One of the ways that the greedy have gotten around declaration and restriction and the use of amendments is *party planks and platforms*^v. We have a very small percentage of we the people in the party conventions. And a very small percent of the conventions decide the planks and the platforms of each party. More and more these planks have come to contain specific plans of actions which affect both the people and the country⁵. These plans can not be, constitutionally, carried out without the people ratifying an amendment, giving congress such powers. With this we the people are told these planks and the platforms are what we the people want. Yet without a vote on a proposed amendment it is not possible to know that^{vi}.

We then are given the choice to vote for one of the two party platforms, represented by some candidates. The ugliness, of the political campaigns that follow, adds to the people's confusion. Then when one of the two parties has won⁶ the winners claim a mandate from the people to do whatever the party committee decided we the people wanted. This without having the constitutionally delegated power or an amendment granting such power.

The worst part of all this is, by the time they are done, way too many believe, that in some magical way, they have actually conjured the will of we the people. And we are lured so deeply into the debate over the given solutions that we lose any thought that there are in fact a multitude of better ways to solve the problems^{vii}. Most often these better solutions would include that the federal government do nothing at all. Often if left to the people to do as each would there would be no problem at all.

This has led us to where we are today, fighting each other over which platform will rule. We the people give more of our power and money to the government, while losing, more and more, of our right to choose. We are going back to the same problems those who ratified our constitution worked so hard to get away from. They understood the problems that this abuse and misconstruction of power will

cause^{viii} and came up with the solution to this historic problem. The only way to repair the problem is to return to the understanding and application of the elements of our constitution. That includes the use of amendments. The problems which are caused by not keeping the use of amendments have and do cause far greater harm and hurt, than any harm or hurt which the use of amendments ever could, or would.

We should note that:

1. it takes far less fanfare, turmoil and enterprise to purpose and vote on an amendment than that produced by the least of the current federal elections.
2. The use of amendments does and will work for making changes in our government, even with all the intricacies and complexities of modern super government.
3. Amendments give to the people the control of vesting power in our government.
4. They prevents, greatly, the abuse and misconstruction of the powers we do vest in the government.
5. Amendments give, a true understanding of, the heart, will and desire of we the people on any given point.
6. They are the method chosen by those highly knowledgeable men and women who were responsible for the ratification of our constitution.
7. And amendments are part of the elements of our constitution which we the people must come back to, so that, the people may regain and maintain the right to choose and their liberty.

2nd Timothy 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: 17 That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.

Jesus Christ accomplished our salvation in his birth, life, death, resurrection, ministry after his resurrection, ascension to the right hand of God and sending back holy spirit on the day of Pentecost. But the lord Jesus Christ did not explain all that he accomplished, what his accomplishments mean to those who believe on him, or what the believers were to do because of his accomplishments. He told his disciples that the gift of holy spirit would provide all that information.

John 14:26 But the Comforter, *which is* the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

The Apostle Paul in his Epistles of Romans through Thessalonians gives us that truth. Paul by revelation sets forth all that Christ accomplished.

Galatians 1:11 But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man. 12 For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught *it*, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.

And, by manifestation of holy spirit, the revelation of Jesus Christ, he completed the Word of God giving us what Christ accomplishments means to those who would believe on him and what they were to do because of that.

Colossians 1:25 Whereof I am made a minister, according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfil the word of God; 26 *Even* the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: 27 To whom God would make known what *is* the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:

In that teaching the Apostle Paul sets forth that when men confess Jesus as lord and believe God has raised him from the dead that they are born again of God's gift of holy spirit, Romans 10:9&10. They then can manifest that spirit and are a part of the body of Christ. One profit of that manifestation is speaking in tongues.

1st Corinthians 14:5 I would that ye all spake with tongues,....

1st Corinthians 14:18 I thank my God, I speak with tongues more than ye all:

These manifestations give power to the church, power that God wants His Church to have. The devil does all he can by way of his men and women to keep those born again sons and daughters of God from knowing the truth concerning the manifestations and operating them. The best work that I know concerning these God given manifestations is Dr. Victor Paul Wierwille's book *Receiving the holy spirit today*. Of all the teaching on his topic, Wierwille's work is the most accurate and complete.

There are many wonderful believers and ministers who have been very misled by the devil in the area of the manifestations. Their hearts are pure but they have been led to wrong teaching, fear and confusion on the subject. The devil has reviled the manifestations, using wrong teaching, embarrassment and confusion to keep those who would walk for the true God from knowing all God has for them. The Church needs this power in manifestation, that is why God gave us the gift. We in keeping His Word and Will need to honestly look at the teaching that is available and do God's will.

Ecclesiastes 12:13 Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this *is* the whole *duty* of man.

iii We the people by way of two thirds of our our state legislatures or our federal legislature will first recommend a change, addition or deletion of powers granted or delegated to our federal government. Then, either by three quarters of our state elected legislatures or elected state conventions, we the people will then decide if we want such a change - Article V - The Congress, whenever two thirds of both Houses shall deem it necessary, shall propose Amendments to this Constitution, or, on the Application of the Legislatures of two thirds of the several States, shall call a Convention for proposing Amendments, which, in either Case, shall be valid to all Intents and Purposes, as part of this Constitution, when ratified by the Legislatures of three fourths of the several States, or by Conventions in three fourths thereof, as the one or the other Mode of Ratification may be proposed by the Congress; Provided that no Amendment which may be made prior to the Year One thousand eight hundred and eight shall in any Manner affect the first and fourth Clauses in the Ninth Section of the first Article; and that no State, without its Consent, shall be deprived of its equal Suffrage in the Senate.

As the proposing of amendments is in both the modes to depend, in the first immediately, in the second, ultimately, on Congress, no amendments of the proper kind would ever be obtained by the people, if the Government should become oppressive, as he verily believed would be the case.

701 WEDNESDAY, JUNE 20 – 710 He proceeded to make some observations on the plan itself and the arguments urged in support of it. The point of Representation could receive no elucidation from the case of England. The corruption of the boroughs did not proceed from their comparative smallness: but from the actual fewness of the inhabitants, some of them not having more than one or two. A great inequality existed in the Counties of England. Yet the like complaint of peculiar corruption in the small ones had not been made. The convention would go on to make the ultimate ratification of an amendment the peoples choice, via their elected State or Convention representatives.

To actually know the will of the majority of the people takes fifty one percent, one hundred and sixty five million people polled or surveyed. Polls and surveys worth is only accepted because it is a useful tool for those who seek our power and money. 2. we have no understanding of the consequences of allowing this, arrogate, seizing of our power.
3. We do not understand why amendments were to be used,
4. that amendments will work,
5. why it is so important we only allow any additions, deletion or change in federal government powers by amendments.
6. Lastly, too many citizens believe being a well kept slave of the state is a good way to live.
